### Minutes of Meeting of Citizens for San Andreas

August 30, 2007

The meeting was opened by Jim Kavanagh with an update of the Board of Supervisors' meeting on August 21<sup>st</sup> regarding the Community Plans. The communities of Copperopolis, Valley Springs, the Blue Mountain communities and San Andreas, will be responsible for their own Community Plans. The county may help if time allows, but there will be no money available.

We are trying to find out what the time frame will be in order for us to stay on top of it and have our Community Plan ready when the county is ready for us. This will coincide with the timing for the General Plan. General Plan Coordinator, Lynn O'Connor, stated that our time frame has not yet been determined. But she will let us know.

Group Discussion----How often should we meet? An informal show of hands determined we should meet every two weeks. NEXT MEETING IS ON THURSDAY, SEPTEMBER 13 AT 5:30 AT THE TOWN HALL.

A discussion on whether we can share members' phone numbers and e-mail addresses was voted on with a show of hands. Twenty-eight agreed we do NOT share and 2 disagreed. The reason for the discussion was that some members thought it would be nice to have a contact list of members to call or e-mail to discuss projects or to ask for help on a project.

Sharon Romano presented her group's evaluation of the strengths of the current Community Plan for San Andreas. She felt that it is still a very good plan and it will not be necessary to revise the whole thing. She felt it is very doable and we can make it applicable to our community.
