

MEETING MINUTES OF CITIZENS FOR CITIZENS FOR SAN ANDREAS
SEPTEMBER 13, 2007

Jim Kavanagh opened the meeting with an apology for the delay in getting the map report on the website and stated it will be there very soon.

Marj Geiszler suggested we put signs around town again for the meeting on the 27th, at the Town Hall at 7:00 P.M., since it will be a wrap up of the results. Jim will e-mail Buzz Eggleston to announce the meeting in the paper. Tillman Sherman and Sharon Romano will prepare a power point presentation of the survey results for the meeting.

Jim presented the fact that our group has no money or even a bank account. He asked how everyone would feel about doing fund-raisers. Comments came back that we should concentrate on the Community Plan and not lose time doing fundraising. It was then suggested we just pass a hat and everyone give what they can. We actually, through everyone's generosity, collected \$150! So we are now working on opening an account at El Dorado Savings here in town.

Marian Coahran requested that we present a financial report at each meeting. Jim agreed.

Community Transportation Planning Grant---Zerrall McDaniels presented what SAM has tentatively planned if this grant is awarded to them. They hope to put in some decorative downtown lighting and new gateway signs at each end of San Andreas, and some possible road improvements, as part of the beautification of our little town. There may also be a Farmers' Market, Kite Day, a Christmas Fest, Miss Kitty Days, a Halloween Carnival, and revival of the Met building with some local professional entertainment, and a new Performing Arts Theater at the high school.

Tom Infusino presented an outline of the Community Draft Process, which he wrote for us .He also spoke of some ways he may be able to provide us with some help with reviewing and presenting our updated Community Plan. He stated that the Community Plan that we hope will be included in the General Plan will need to be completed before the EIR. He stated that the actual writing of our Community Plan will be done by the county, using the input we present as our vision process. Tom said he will get the global list of elements e-mailed to everyone so we can all decide which ones we feel should be included in the Plan.

Lynn O'Conner, General Plan Coordinator for the county, announced that they now have numerous books of various titles pertaining to planning, soon to be available at the Calaveras County Library for public viewing.

Jim adjourned the meeting at 7:10 P.M.
