

Minutes for Citizens for San Andreas  
November 15, 2007

Lynn O' Conner spoke and clued us in on what our contribution might be for the General Plan. She suggested we don't get bogged down on details. She suggested we determine boundaries, with an alternative set of boundaries to go with item. She also stated that implementation will be determined by Mintier, so we don't need to work on that aspect either.

She stated that the draft of the General Plan is now available on the website. It is in chapters, very lengthy, and can be downloaded. It might eventually be available at the library in a printed version for browsing there. Vision workshops start Dec. 1 and will go until Dec 12. They are not community specific, only the County General Plan will be discussed, so anyone from any community can go to their choice of meeting date and place.

Diane Keane voiced a concern about the draft we have on our website. The group decided we will all work together on updates to it at the next few meetings.

Pat Guttmann and Marge Geiszler shared their report as a vision statement for San Andreas. They stated that they used our survey to guide them to the conclusion of what most citizens of San Andreas would like to see happen in the future.

Lynn O'Conner again suggested that we don't get hung up on details, but rather keep it to general statements for our vision. She suggested we address housing in S.A. as in 2009 affordable housing has to be implemented.

There was some discussion on how to promote our group. Lynn O'Conner suggested we have a public service TV presentation. Donna Schantz offered to look into it.

It was suggested that we help promote the Vision Meeting hosted by the county on December 6, by putting out signs around town and passing out flyers at the PO and Treats on the Monday before, Dec 3.

The meeting adjourned about 7:30 PM.
